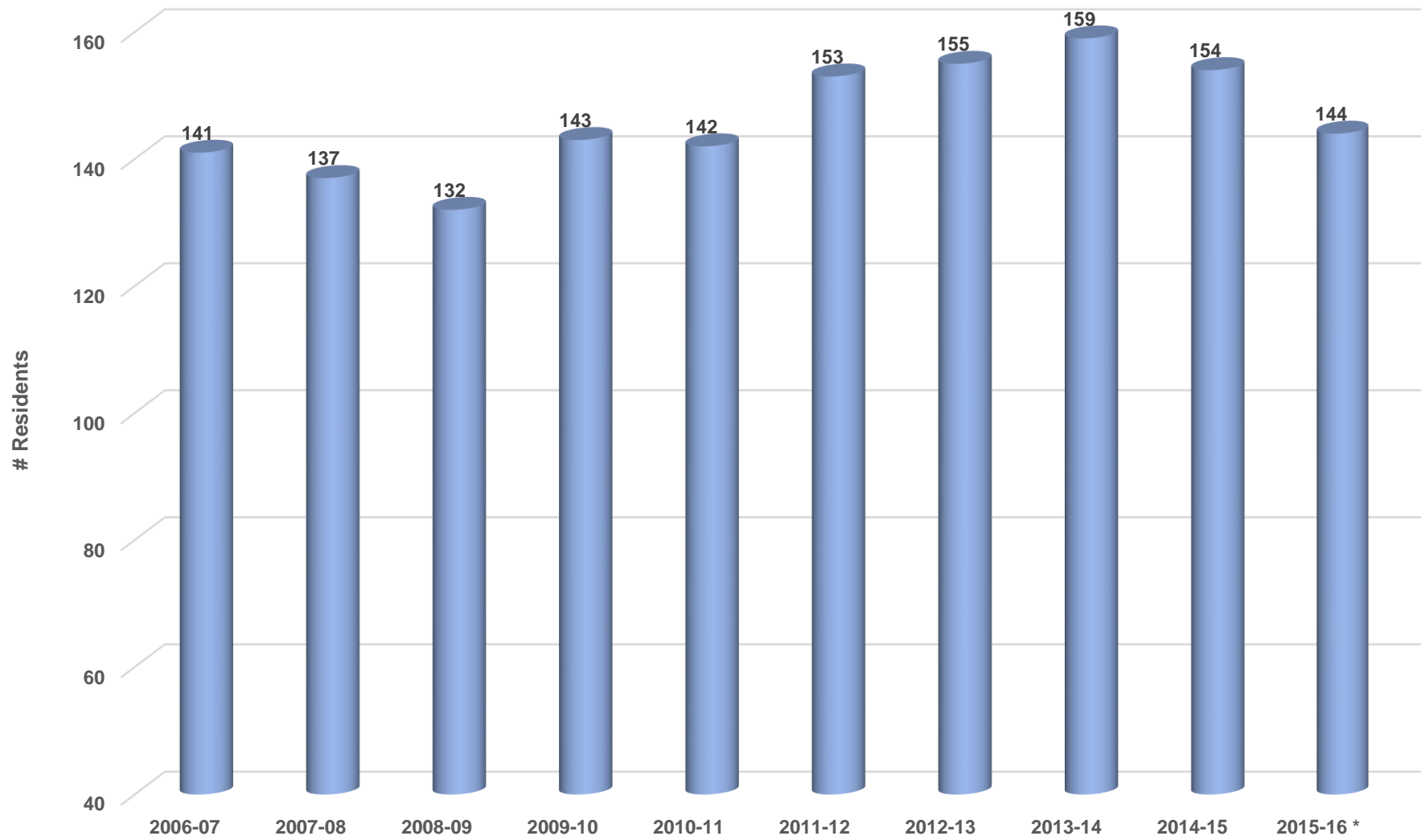

Statewide Totals Family Medicine Residents in Training

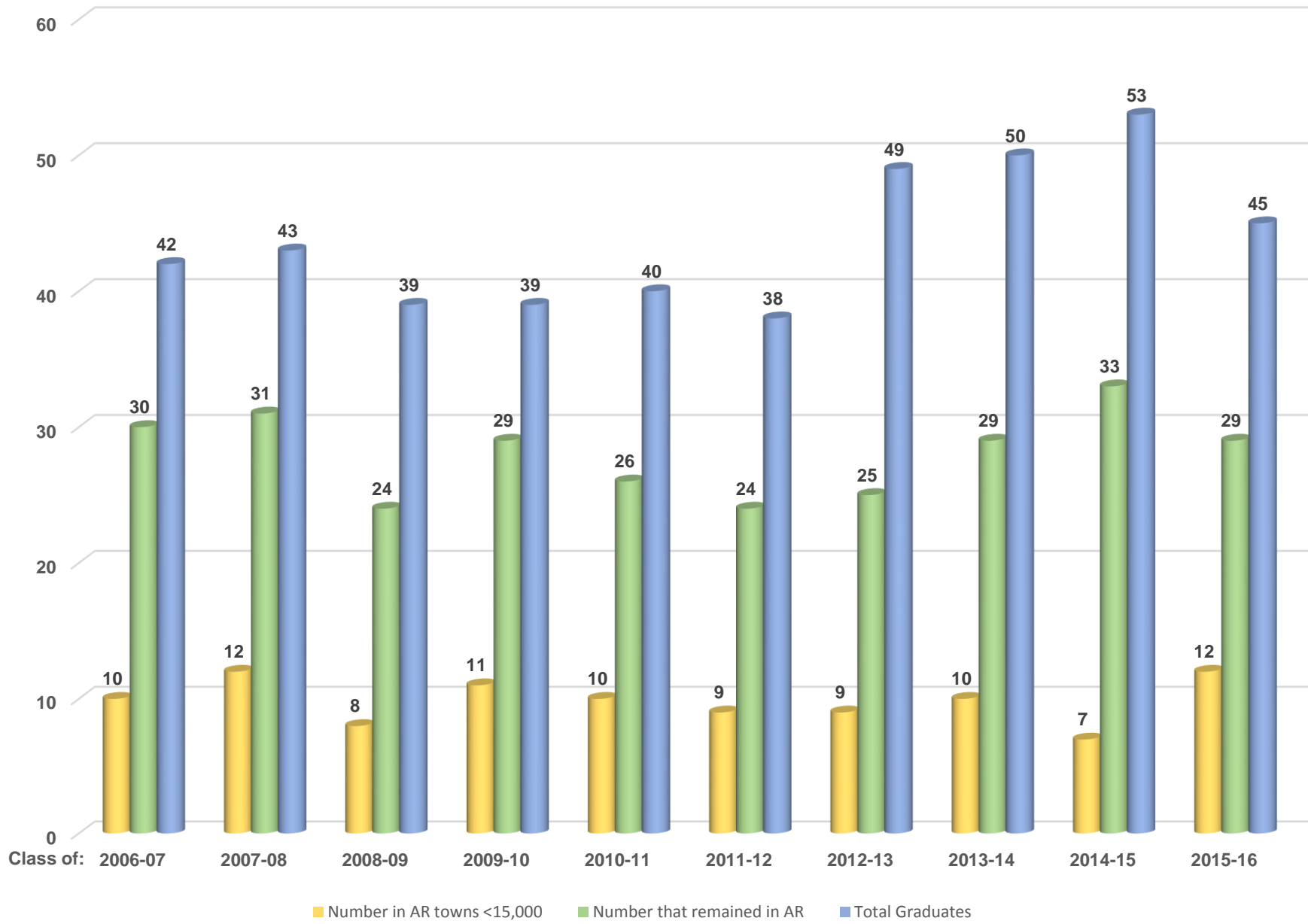


Residents may include:

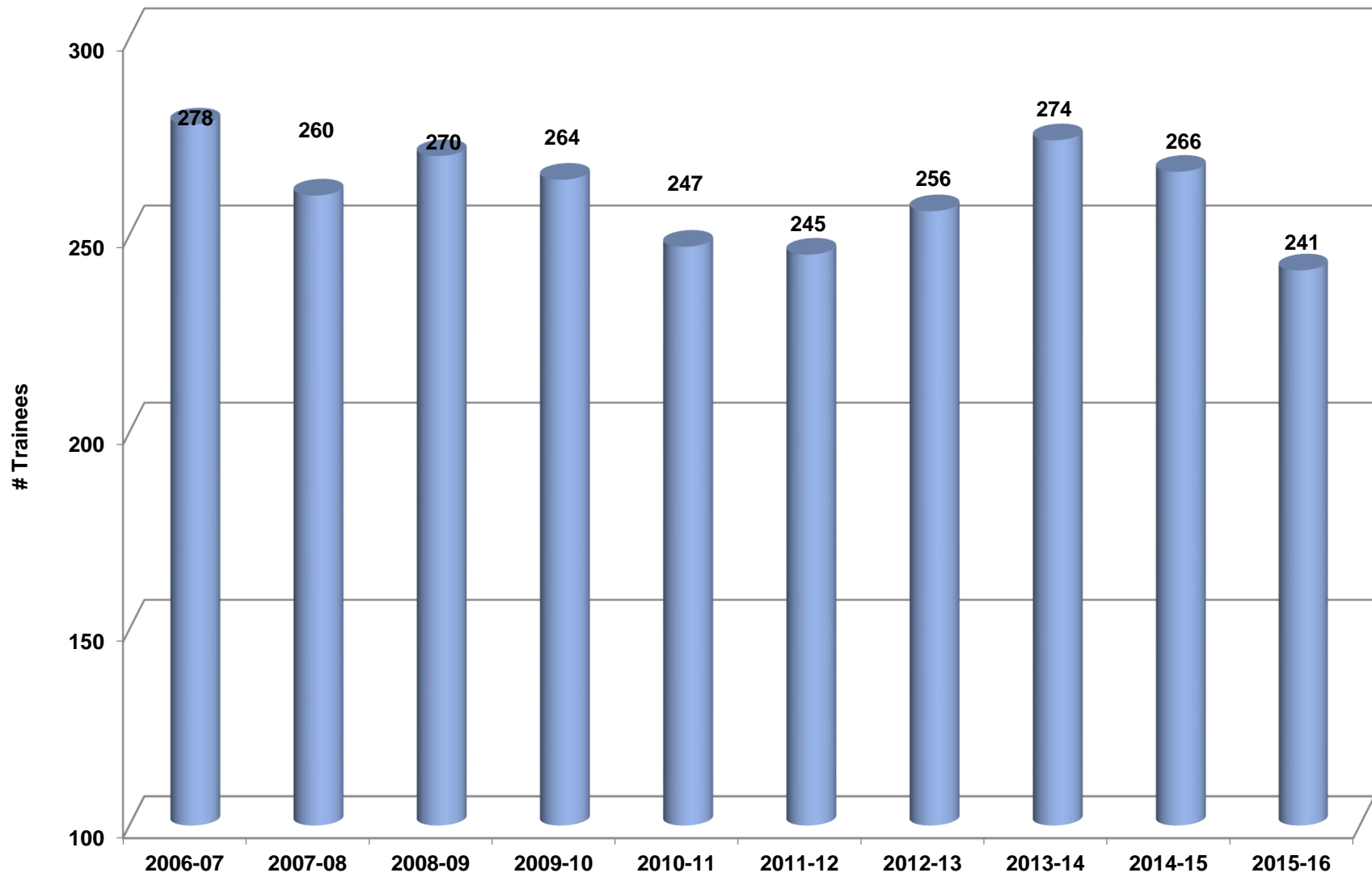
- Regional Centers Family Medicine Residency Programs

Statewide Totals Family Medicine Residency Program Graduates

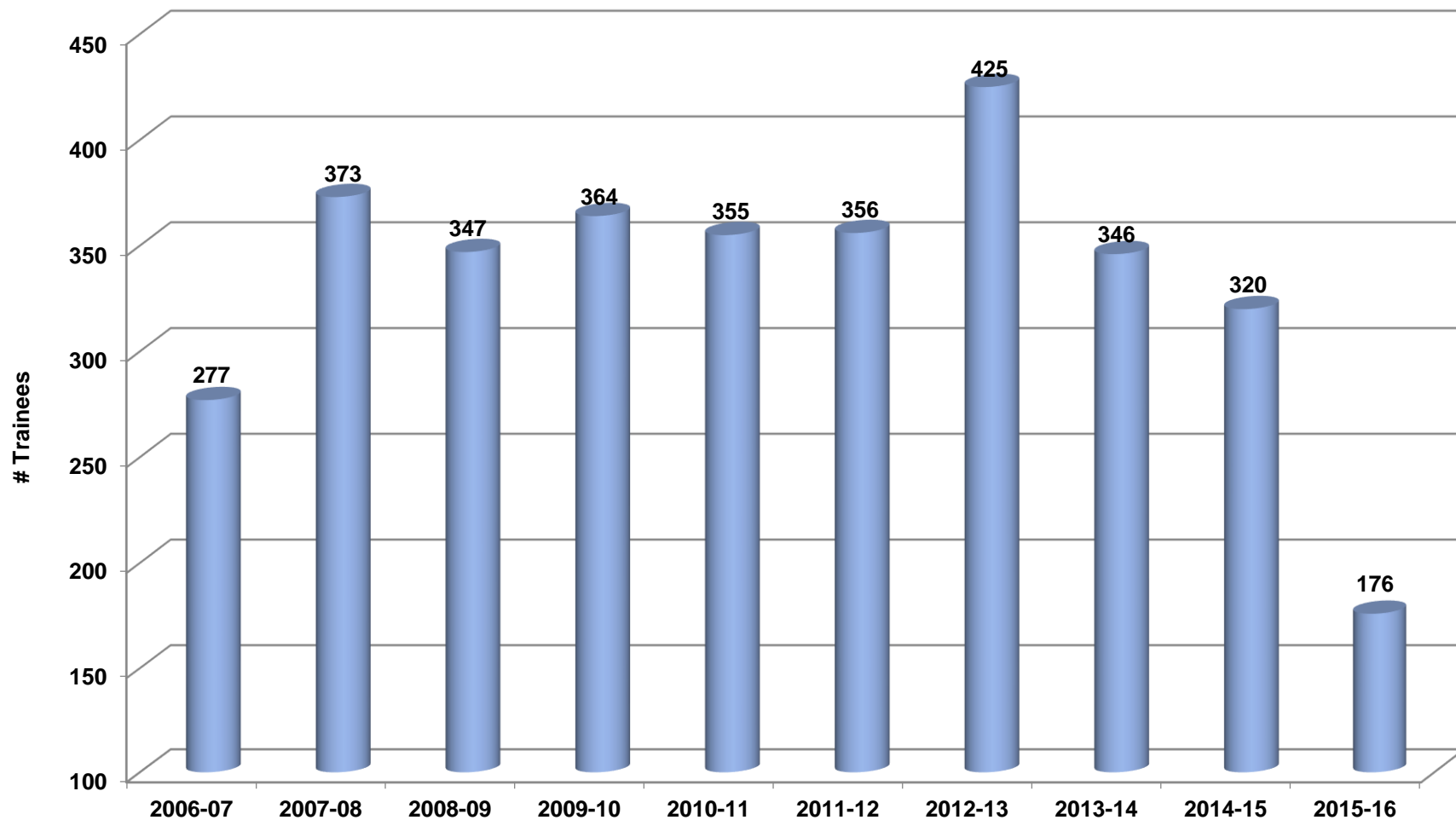


Statewide Totals Medical Students

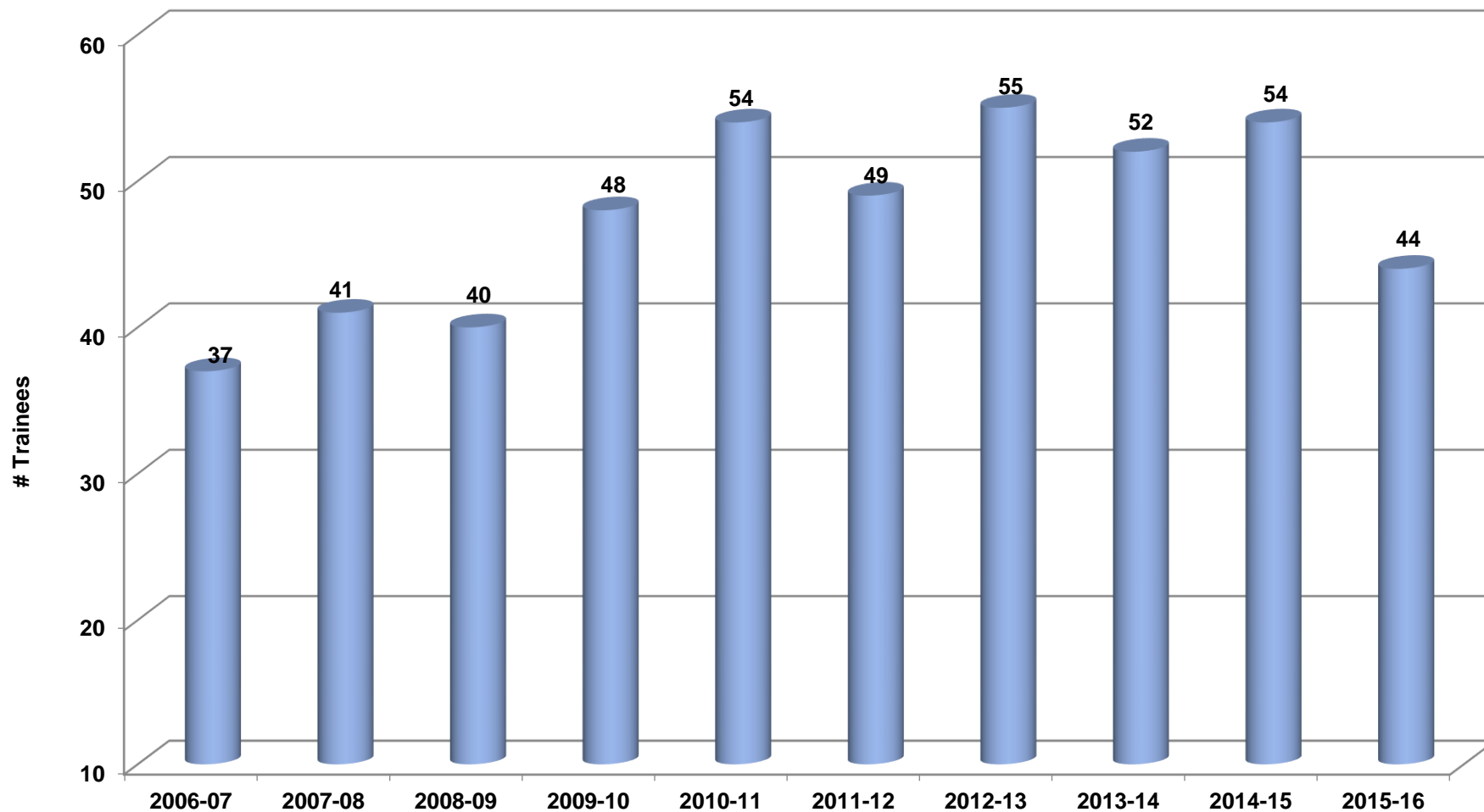
Statewide Totals Nursing

- Nursing Assistant and Home Care Aide Programs

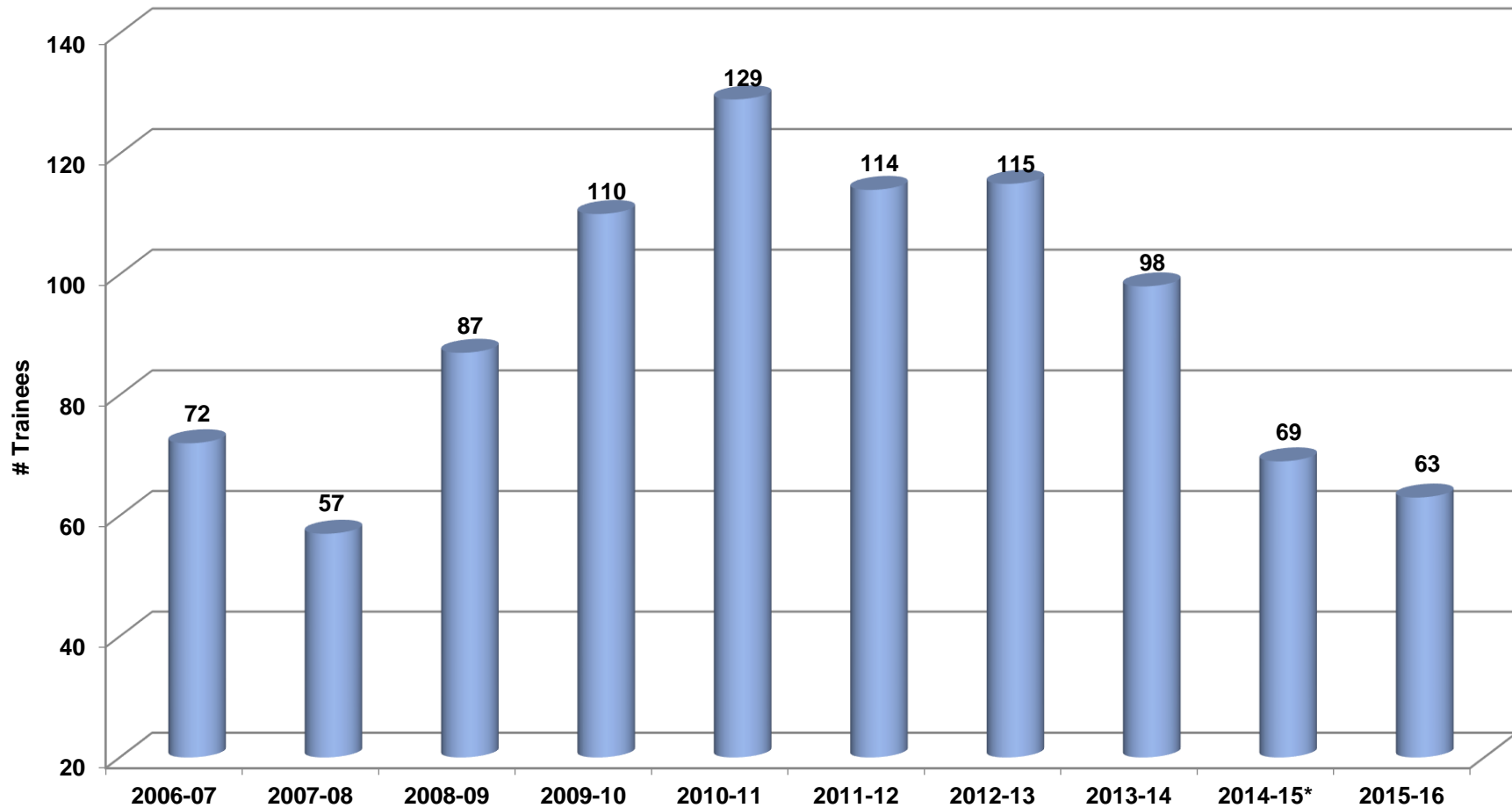
Statewide Totals Pharmacy

Statewide Totals Health Professions

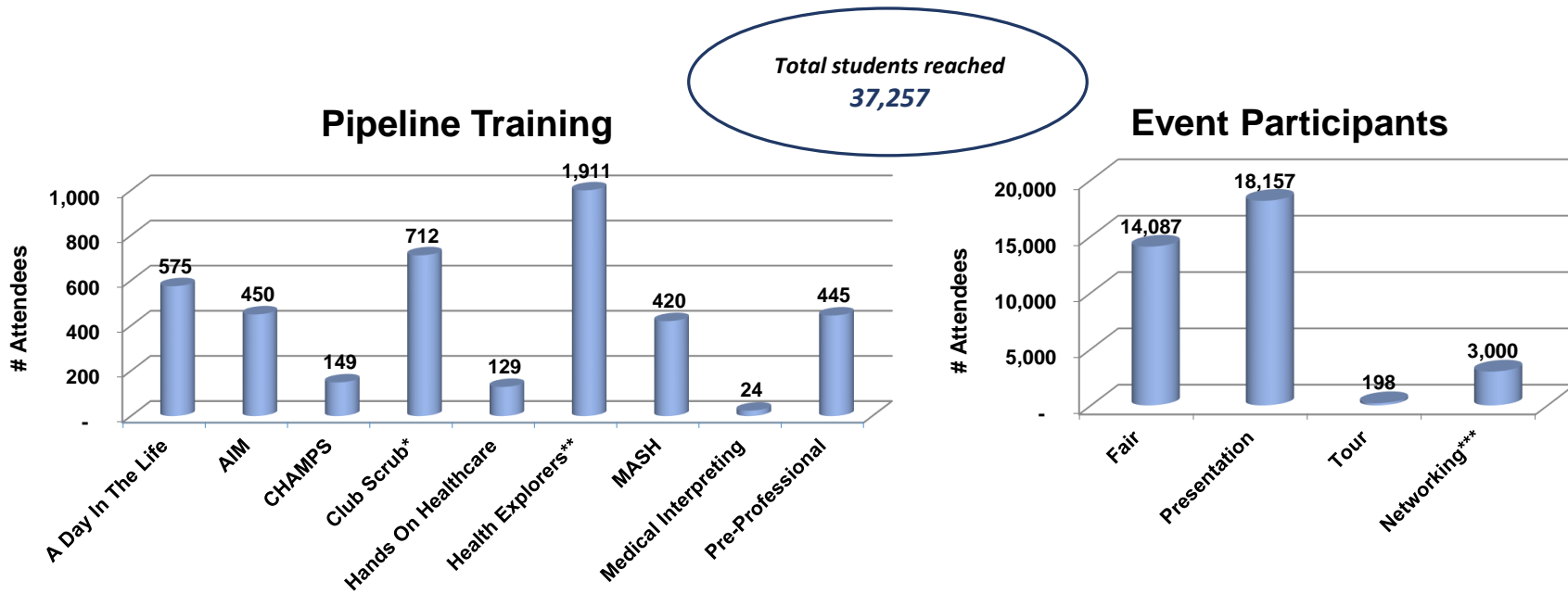


Trainees may include:

* Several programs across the state were phased out & new UAMS Physician Assistant (PA) student rotations began.

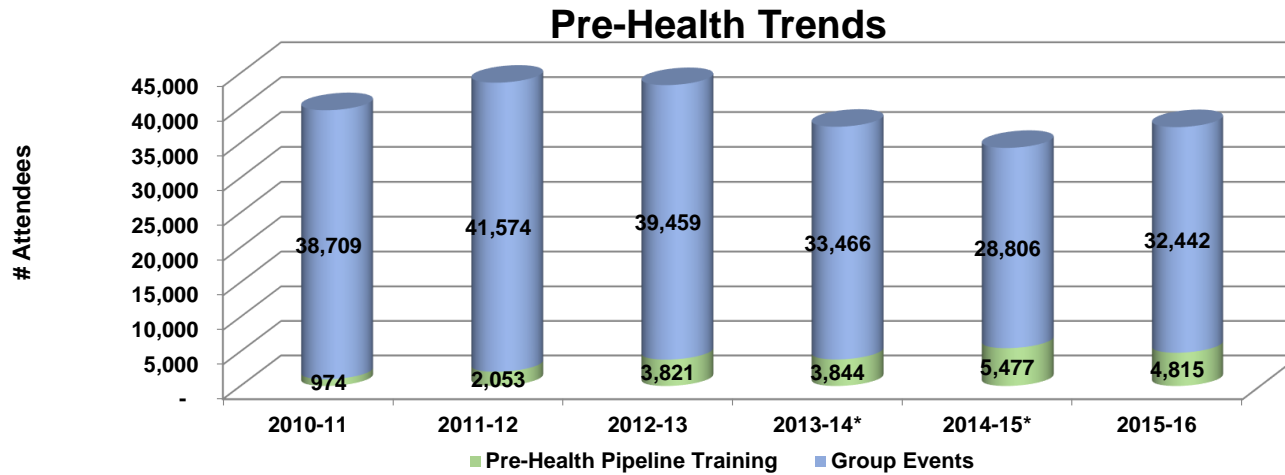
Statewide Pre-Health Activities 2015-2016



* Club Scrub total includes Med Pro Ed

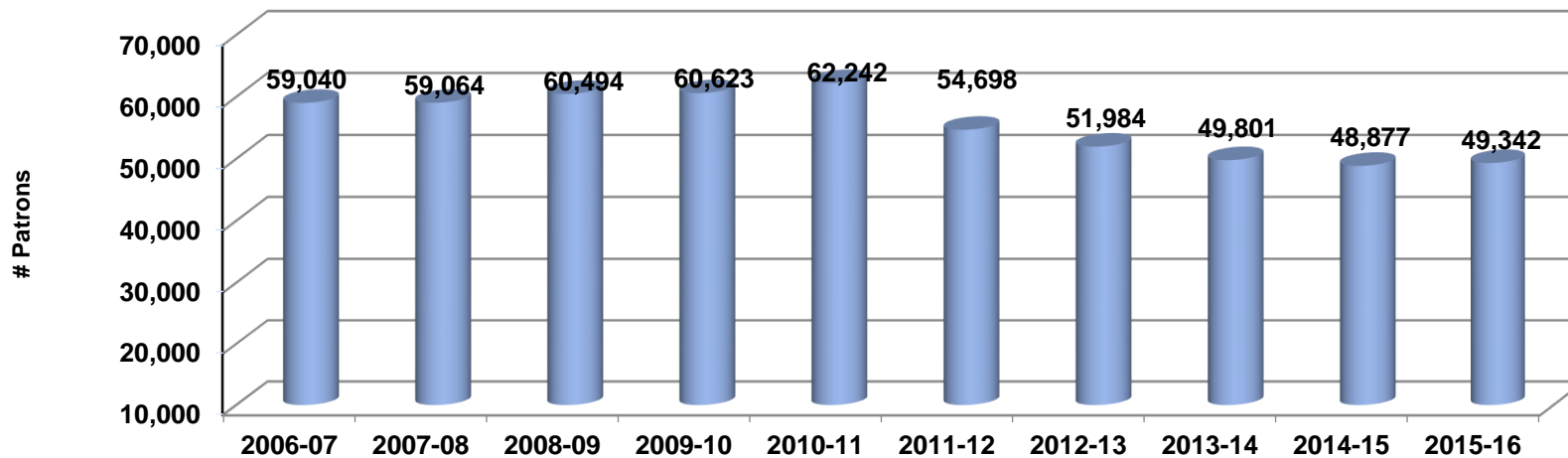
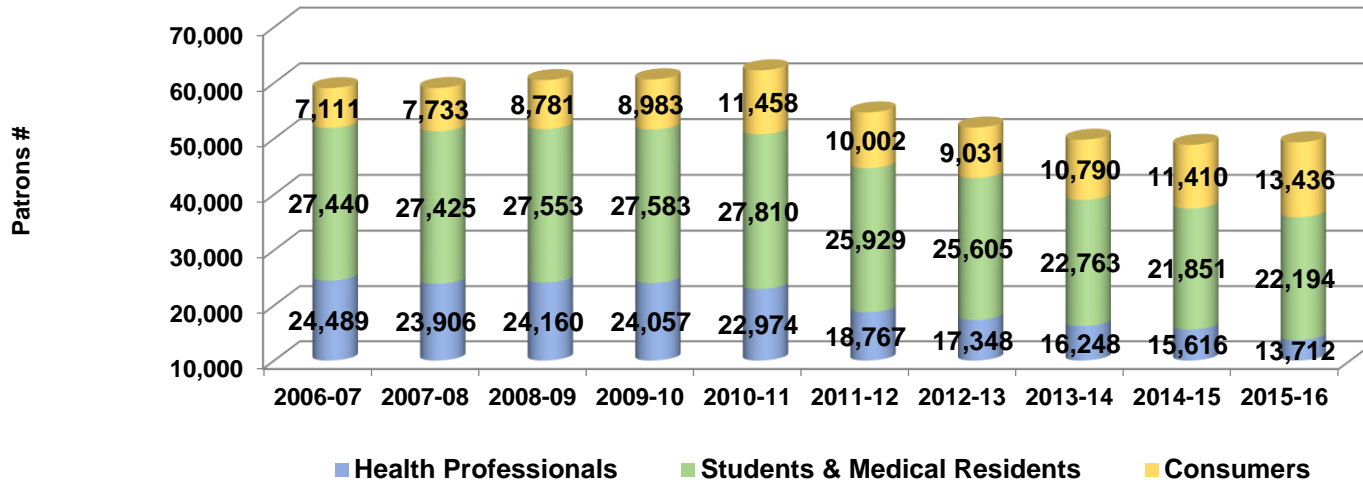
